

Reporting Boundaries

G As a REIT, we are not permitted to participate in the management of hotels under ownership, and therefore we do not have operational control of our hotels. However, we exert influence over the management of our properties through approval of operating budgets and capital expenditures for the hotels, and then use those rights to continually monitor and improve the performance of the hotels in our portfolio.

Our portfolio is concentrated in key gateway cities and destination resort locations. Each of our hotels is managed by a third party and most are operated under a brand owned by one of the leading global lodging brand companies (Marriott International, Inc. ("Marriott"), Starwood Hotels & Resorts Worldwide, Inc. ("Starwood") and Hilton Worldwide ("Hilton")).

Please note that our hotels use a limited amount of hazardous waste, which may include oils related to the maintenance of HVAC systems. In Question 27.1, we state zero tons of hazardous waste in the portfolio based on an assumption that totals were less than one ton during the reporting period.
